What are the selection criteria?

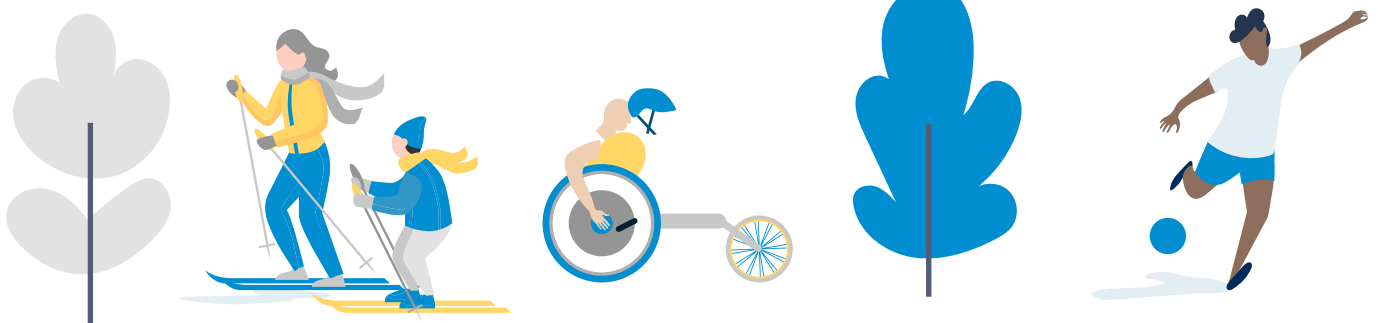
As a Young Delegate you need to fit the following criteria:

- You are 18 - 30 years,
- You are interested and have experience within the field of sports,
- As a volunteer you are ready to commit to the cause and be actively involved in our work,
- You are confident using English in a working environment.

The following experience or skills would be an asset:

- Previous experience within the topic/s: Sports and Education and Employability, Sustainable Development, Sport Diplomacy, Health, Inclusion, etc.,
- Project management skills,
- Experience in youth work.

The YD mandate is for 2 years with the possibility of applying again if criteria is met. New calls are every 2 years after General Assembly.
