2. INTRODUCTION

Founded in 2008 in Santiago de Chile, we have grown into an international Sport for Development NGO with presence in 8 countries: Chile, Peru, Ecuador, Haiti, Paraguay, Mexico, France and Kenya. Every week about 9,500 children participate in our programme in challenging environments throughout Latin



America, the Caribbean, Europe and recently also Africa. We're a social and community-based programme using football as a vehicle for social change and happiness. For more information go to http://www.futbolmas.org/en/.

In Kenya we work in two communities of Nairobi, one in Mathare and one in Kibera. At the community levels the team of Futbol Mas professionals consists of physical education or sports professionals and social sciences professionals (psychologist, social worker or related careers). They are the direct link and presence in the community, responsible of programme implementation.

3. JOB DESCRIPTION

As Community Coordinator for Mathare, you will work closely with our Community Coach in the direct implementation and coordination of the Futbol Mas sessions and other activities, according to our award-winning methodology and under the supervision of the Social Coordinator. Your main responsibility will be to coordinate and facilitate the optimal implementation of the programme's key action lines, especially regarding the involvement and ownership of the community stakeholders. Therefore you will need to maintain and continue building relationships with adult caregivers, youth leaders, the management and



teachers of our partner schools and other community-based groups, as well as engaging with the children and adolescents that participate in our social sport sessions.

- ✓ Planning and facilitation of social sport sessions together with the Community Coach
- ✓ Coordination and mentoring of Youth Leader group
- ✓ Coordination and training of Community Coordination Team (adult caregivers) with a special emphasis on developing and piloting income generating activities.
- ✓ Building and maintaining positive working relationships with management and teachers of partner schools
- ✓ Increase the community belonging of key stakeholders in Futbol Mas
- ✓ Create, build or contribute to community spaces targeted towards integration and cohesion
- ✓ Produce monthly monitoring report on all activities using the Futbol Mas monitoring tools such as the monthly logbook.
- ✓ Participate in weekly team meetings
- ✓ Address targeted cases of children that need individual follow up
- ✓ Manage a database of all children participating in the programme
