Through a partnership with the United Nations, we also work with refugee communities in Nairobi, Kakuma and Dadaab, which has expanded our reach further. Our vision is to create sustainability and scale up where we already are and convince partners around Kenya and beyond to include more communities in the Futbol Mas family. Bringing in your passion, creativity and skills, you will participate in developing the project design in this key programme as part of a strategic partnership with the United Nations working with refugee communities, families and children in Kakuma and Dadaab, based in Nairobi.
